BACKGROUND

Since 2009, OSI started organizing biennial conferences viz. OSICON-09, OSICON-11, OSICON-13, OSICON-15, OSICON-17, OSICON-19, OSICON-21 and OSICON-23. These conferences hosted by leading academic/research institutes viz. Andhra University, Visakhapatnam; NIOT, Chennai; IITM, Pune; CSIR-NIO, Goa; NCESS, Thiruvananthapuram; CMLRE, Kochi; NCPOR, Goa and INCOIS, Hyderabad were very successful in bringing together 500 researchers, students and professionals working in the area of ocean sciences, technology and allied fields to share their knowledge.

OSICON-25 is being hosted by the CSIR-National Institute of Oceanography, Goa, is a constituent laboratory under the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India. CSIR-NIO and OSI are pleased to invite the oceanographic community to this biennial conference, OSICON-25, the 9th National Conference scheduled to be held during 5-7 February 2025.

The CSIR-NIO with its headquarters at Dona Paula, Goa, and regional centres at Kochi, Mumbai and Visakhapatnam, is one of the 37 constituent laboratories of the Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR), New Delhi. CSIR-NIO was established on 1 January 1966 following the International Indian Ocean Expedition (IIOE) in the 1960s. The institute has since grown into a multi-disciplinary oceanographic research institute of international repute. The principal focus of research has been on observing and understanding special oceanographic characteristics of the Indian Ocean.

CSIR-NIO will be celebrating its Diamond Jubilee in 2025, and OSICON-25 will be a flagship programme of the Diamond Jubilee celebrations.

FOCAL THEME

The focal theme 'Sustainability of Oceans and Climate Change' underscores the critical interplay between ocean health and climate stability. Oceans, covering over 70% of the Earth's surface, are pivotal in regulating global climate by absorbing carbon dioxide and heat. However, climate change threatens this balance, leading to ocean warming, acidification, and rising sea levels. Sustainable practices are essential to protect marine ecosystems, support biodiversity, and ensure the livelihoods of communities dependent on ocean resources.



The focal theme of this conference, 'Sustainability of Oceans and Climate Change', is intricately linked with the United Nations Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development (2021-2030). This pivotal UN initiative aims to drive transformative ocean science solutions for sustainable development, connecting people and the ocean in unprecedented ways. As the Decade emphasizes the necessity of a healthy, resilient, and productive ocean, our conference's focus on sustainable practices and climate change mitigation resonates deeply with these global objectives.

By fostering interdisciplinary collaboration and innovation, this conference contributes to the Decade's vision of reversing the cycle of decline in ocean health and ensuring a sustainable future. It underscores the urgency of addressing climate impacts on marine ecosystems and highlights the essential role of scientific knowledge in shaping effective conservation policies.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Extended abstracts, focused on scientific or operational results and applications, must be submitted through the conference website: **osicon25.nio.res.in**. The abstract should be a maximum of two A4 pages and include the title, author name(s), their affiliation(s), and five relevant keywords.

Each author is allowed to submit only one abstract as the first author. When submitting, ensure the name of the corresponding author is provided, along with the preferred mode of presentation (oral/poster) and the chosen theme.

Once reviewed and accepted by the peer review committee, authors will be notified regarding the acceptance and assigned mode of presentation. Templates for posters and extended abstracts will be available on the conference website, and the extended abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings.
