REPORT

Report of the Awareness programme on "OCEAN" conducted under auspices of OCEAN SOCIETY OF INDIA at Sree Narayana College, Cherthala on 12/01/2018 for school children as part of the outreach programme of the society

The major objectives of the Ocean Society of India (OSI) are advancement and dissemination of knowledge in Science, Technology, Engineering and allied fields related to oceans. It provides a forum for sharing the knowledge and experience of individuals, scientific institutions and industrial organizations for promoting the said objectives and acts as a link among academic and R&D institutions, national policy making bodies, operational organisations and ocean industries by organizing programs such as courses, lectures, symposia and topical reviews. OSI will also provide periodic and special publications for dissemination of scientific and technical information. The Society is a non-profit organisation solely devoted to academic pursuits in science, engineering, technology and allied fields related to oceans. Organizing the outreach programme is yet another function of the society.

Background: The programme was organized in the wake of Ockhi storm disaster occurred in South India recently. In the wake of this event, adequate awareness pgramme had to be organized for disseminating knowledge on **oceans**, and its behaviour during different seasons to various segments of the society. For this, organizing awareness programme has been one of the viable proposals. The OSI believed that if such awareness classes could be conducted to school children, then it would have a far reaching and long standing effect in the society. More over such events can bring in great fame to OSI and also it will be an effective mechanism to spread about the activities of OSI.

Awareness programme

The programme was conducted for the school and college students at Cherthala area of the state. The OSI contacted the schools in the Government sector in regard and nearly 10 schools were contacted. Major constraint was availability of facility. In this respect, one of the leading colleges in this area, Sree Narayana College was consulted and the Princiapl was kind enough to extend all facilities to conduct the programme and also nominated Dr. Meera V., the Head of the Department of Chemistry and Geology to organize the programme on 12/01/2018. The programme was organized jointly by Ocean Society of India & Sree Narayana College, Cherthala.

1. Inauguration: 10.00 am

The Inaugural programme was chaired by Dr. C. Revichandran, OSI Joint Secretary and inaugurated by Prof. Dr. K. S. Purushan, Former Dean, Faculty of Fisheries, KAU & Former Member, Fishermen Debt. Relief Commission, Govt. of Kerala. Dr. K. B. Manoj, Principal, S. N. College was the chief guest. Prof. Prasada Rao, G C member. OSI offered the falicitation. Dr. Meera Vasundhathi, General Convener offered welcome address and Prof. Dr. K. V. Jayachandran, G. C. Member, OSI expressed vote of thanks.

2. Awareness classes: 11.00 am

Three classes on ocean related topics were taken by eminent persons –

- a. Prof. Dr. K. S. Purushan, Former Dean Fisheries, KAU, gave a talk on Oceans, its importance in economy, food security, climate, weather and so on
- b. Dr. C V K Prasad Rao, Former Scientist of NPOL delivered a talk on climate, weather, calamities in ocean, tsunami, ockhi, ocean current and similar topics
- c. Dr. Dhanya Viswam, Assistant Professor, S N College interacted with students about the chemistry of sea water.

The students were really enjoyed the talks and there were good interactive discussions.

4. Exhibition: From 10.00 am to 4.30 am

Equipments and scientific charts were exhibited at another hall in the College. These were viewed by students and teachers of the college. It gave a lot of information to students and otherwise they were not in a position to get familiarized with ocean related scientific research. The scientists, Research scholars from NIO and CMLRE have sincerely participated in this programme. This has created a lot of enthusiasm among students.
